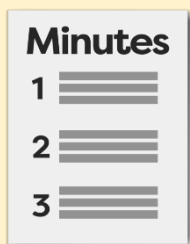

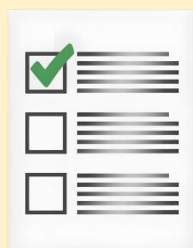


1. **Introductions:** Jo welcomed everyone to the meeting, and everyone introduced themselves.

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2. **Notes of last meeting:** Jo went through the minutes of the last meeting. The only action from the last meeting is completed by Kerry P attending today's meeting. Minutes were agreed as correct.



3. **Louise reminded the Board that there was an outstanding action for Claire from a previous meeting** – request for Claire to bring information about people who had not had a CTR and admitted to hospital. This includes the numbers, trends and reasons. The Board is interested in getting a better understanding of whether CTRs are helping.



4. **LeDeR and Transforming Care Update.** Claire was not at the meeting to present the update but had prepared a slide deck. It was hard for the Board to make sense of the LeDer information without Claire there to explain the numbers. There is a suicide webinar being planned.



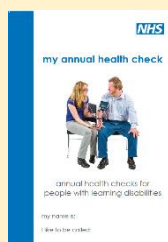

Laura asked for information about the webinar **Action for Claire to share information with the Board**. Jo explained that TC were down, and David said this was good.



1. Update from the Learning Disability Partnership

Michelle updated the board about the voices for all meeting. A positive link up with Alfie from Lincolnshire Young Voices, working together. LPFT attended the meeting and spoke to everyone about annual health checks and what reasonable adjustments helped.



Rosemarie spoke about a logo they have been working on to promote the learning disability partnership that was now with VoiceAbility Coms team.

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David spoke about information the team have been putting together to promote what the speak out service does in Lincolnshire. He asked for a photograph of the board members to add to this. It was felt that with all the upcoming changes within LCC it would be beneficial to do that at the next board meeting.



Peter fed back his personal experience of attending UTC in Lincoln with a friend and the staff not being aware of sensory bags.



2. **All About Me Passports - Update from Kerry Poberzniuk**

Kerry talked to the group about the great work she is doing in updating and reviewing the All About Me Passport. She's been talking to as many people as possible to get it as good as it can be. She explained that some people have different views and that's been difficult as it needs to be right for people. A big change is that it's now written differently – it provides instructions now. She explained that it will be on the website and work is being done to make this happen.

Sheena talked about the Carers Badges that she's helped to introduce. Carer's can wear a badge to access the ward at any time, not just visiting times. They also get free hospital parking. David explained that this was not made available to his mum.



Action: Sheena to provide more information about how to access the Carers Badge.

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Peter explained that he had learned that sensory bags were not available in the urgent treatment centres but are in A&E wards. Kerry explained that the pilot was funded by a charity, and she has applied for more funding for sensory bags. There is a QR code to give feedback on the sensory bags.



Louise asked if the passport will be available for people who use on their phones. Kerry was not sure so said she would check.

Action: Kerry to let David know, who can then update the Board, if the passport is mobile friendly.



Jo and the Board thanked Kerry for coming to the meeting, updating the Board and the great work she is doing.

4. LPFT LD Community Review



Sarah and Nicola introduced the team and the work that is happening in Lincolnshire to review LD services and went through the presentation. Jo explained that lots of changes are happening in Adult Care too and asked Sarah and Nicola to connect with Sara Apps who will be leading some of that work.



Louise suggested to effectively give feedback on the ideas and changes proposed, people will need to understand what the current service consists of. Sara and Nicola agreed and will include a description of this in the engagement information.

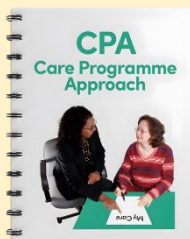
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Jo noted that the length of the engagement period and said this was a good amount of time to help people have their say.

5. **Adult Social Care Target Operating Model or TOM**

Jo explained that work is happening in Adult Care to help make sure we work with people earlier to prevent, reduce and delay need for social care. Jo explained that a lot of good work is happening already, and this is about making this happen more. We call the new way of working the Target Operating Model or TOM for short.



Lots of discussion took place around what is happening already including information and advice.



6. **Any Other Business**

Jo announced her retirement from her role. This means this will be the last meeting that she will chair and Sara Apps will be taking over. Jo explained that we have a new Deputy Director joining LCC later in the month called Hayley Eccles. She might want to come to the Board.



John also announced his retirement – this will be John's last meeting.



John wanted to acknowledge John O'Brien's death. John helped to create Person Centred Planning and was a well know advocate of inclusion.
