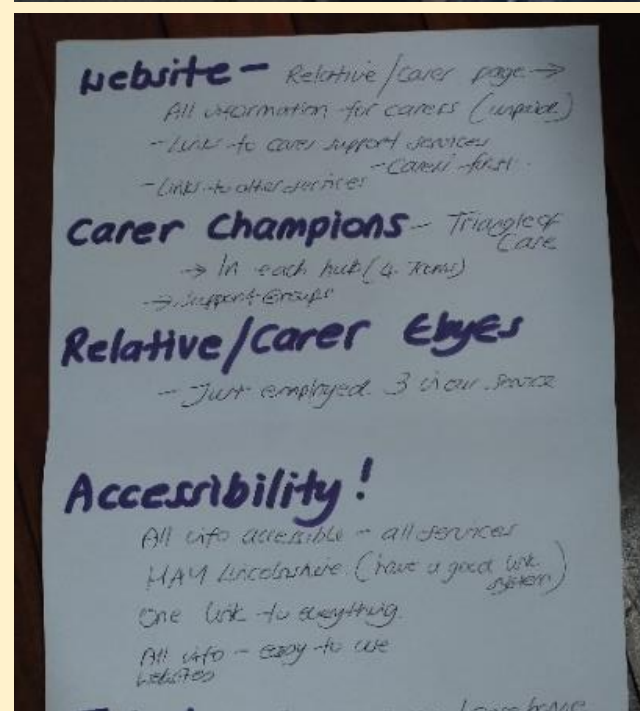

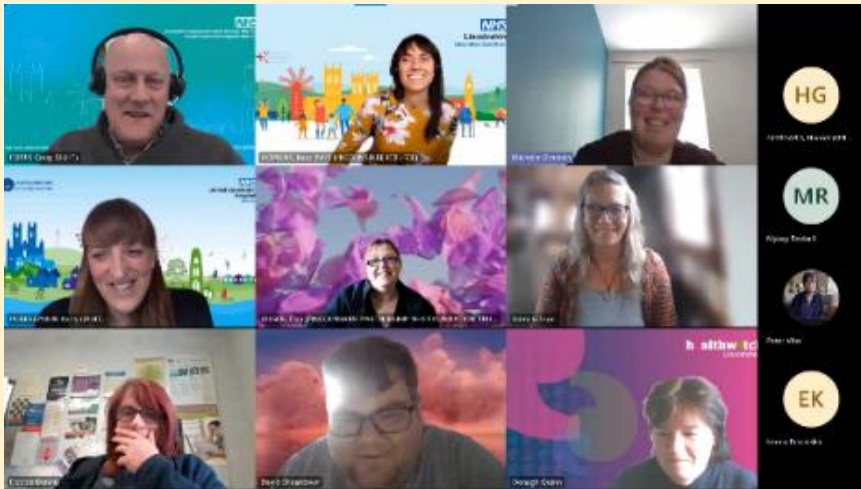

All About Me Hospital Passports

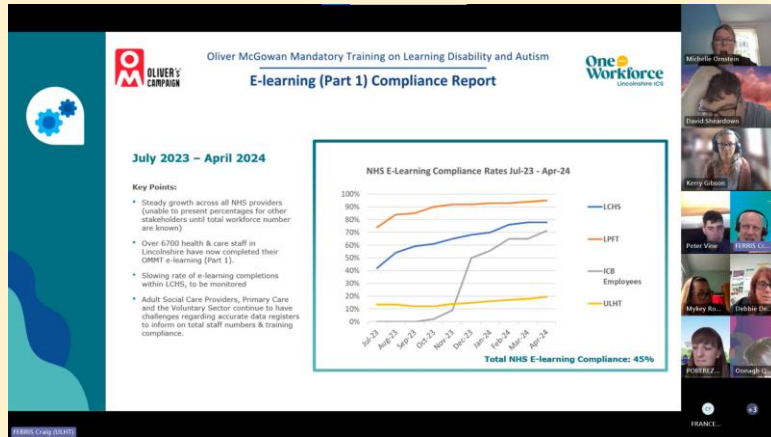
- The hospital passports were first created over 10 years ago.

- Patients, family and carers need to insist they are used and that they stay at the bed side.
- We are promoting awareness of this.

Oliver McGowan Training

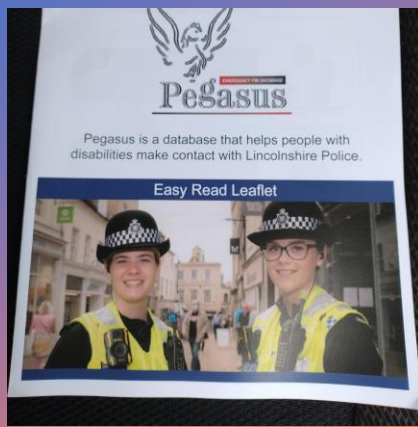
- Craig gave the group feedback on where we are in Lincolnshire with the OMG training.

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- **Pegasus**

- Promotion of the Pegasus scheme has stopped due to work being done so it works better and to make sure everyone knows about it.

- **Mate Crime**

- People in the group talked about how Mate Crime had made them feel.
- The group decided it would be good to make a podcast to let people know about mate crime and what they can do about it.
- The work group is looking at ideas for a poster which would make people think about mate crime and who to go to for help.
- This could then be shared across Lincolnshire in different services.
