### Welcomes and minutes of the last meeting.

Mandy welcomed everyone and everyone introduced themselves.



The minutes of the last meeting were read out by David and agreed.



### Pegasus

Mandy updated by reading out the email from Zara for everyone to think about and talk to Zara with feedback.

The email detailed some proposed changes to the Pegasus scheme to

simplify the process so that officers could have immediate access to it. The proposed changes were:

- Replacing the term Pegasus and the requirement of individual pins so that individuals would only need to say their full name and date of birth.
- Changing cards to be more like awareness cards. Which would be something like, Please contact the police for me with space to write the persons name and date of birth. Please give Zara any suggestions re applying, carrying the card or advertising the scheme wider.
- Feedback or input into the Police negotiators training course as to how to approach someone who may be in burnout or unable to express themselves or their concerns. Zara would like the feedback before November so feedback can be given in one of the SSWG meetings.



Initial concerns were having personal details on a card. The group were happy to have input into the training and suggested they could do a talking book, or to record something to be used in training.



### **Safeguarding leaflet**

The group had been asked to look at 3 different leaflets and feedback their thoughts.

The leaflets were shared and discussed.

The group preferred the Leeds Safeguarding Board one to be used as a template as they liked the stories but with different pictures. It should be available in easy read. Kerry will feedback to her manager.

### **Terms of reference**

The group felt that it was important that:

Individuals were empowered to pass on the information that they had learnt into their own communities. The meetings should be driven by Staying Safe topics.
