- They gave a presentation about what they do now and things that could be part of the service in the future.

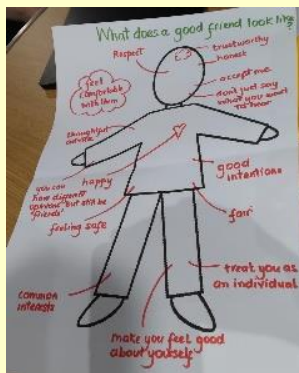
